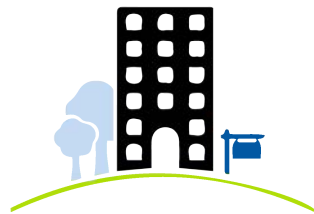

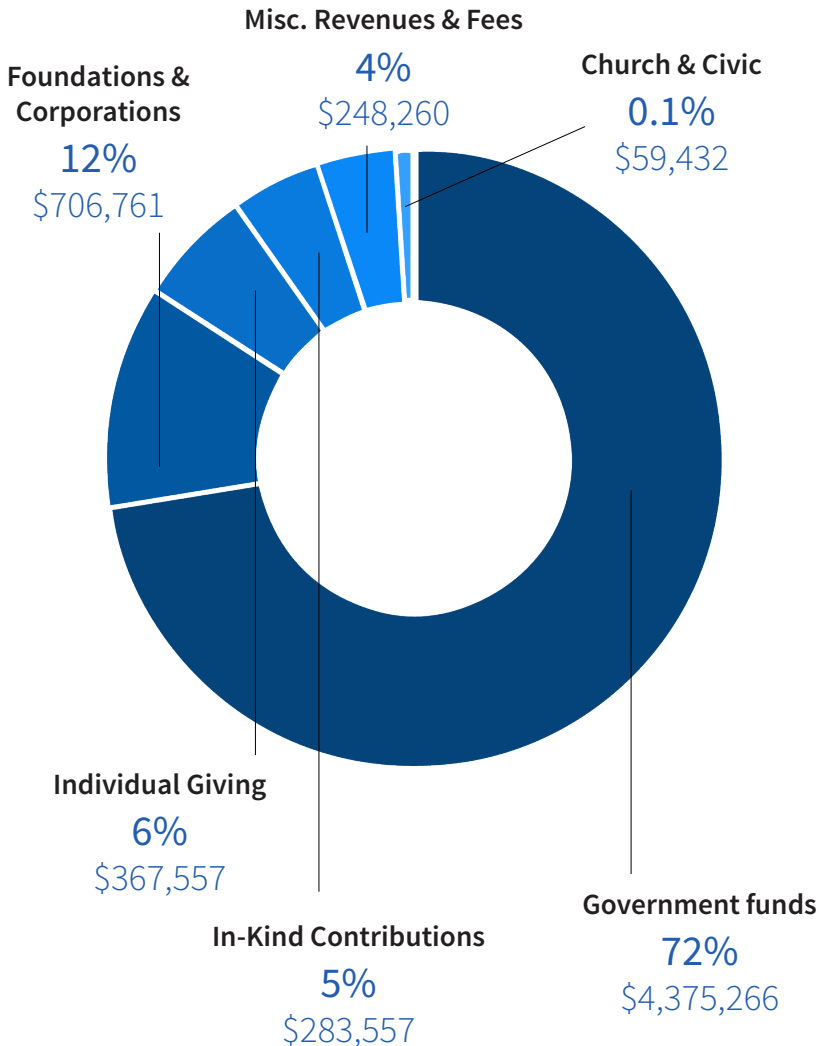

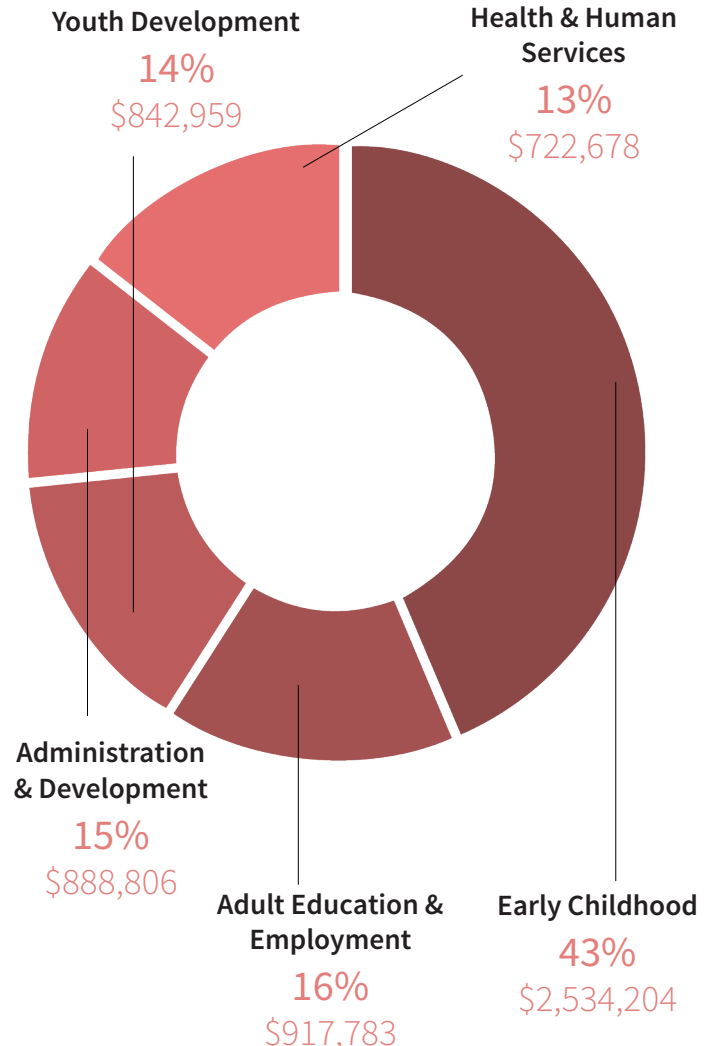
## Where Funds Come From
